I have also entered other competitions such as Typography Day 2017's and 2018's Logo Design Competition and Poster Design Competition.

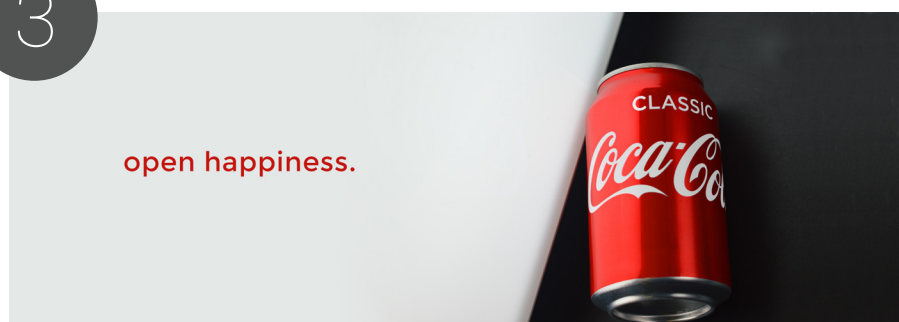
